As of January 1, 2015, the Division of Criminal Investigation Sex Offender Registry will no longer be using Address Verification Forms to complete the Address Verification Process.

In-person verification with your local Sheriff's Department will still be mandatory, based on your registration category.

In addition, all new offenders are required to provide court documentation of the conviction(s) to the Sheriff's Department upon initial registration. If a criminal history shows a sex offense, and no official court documentation is provided, new offenders will be placed into the "O" category.

7-19-302 (o) If the division lacks sufficient information or documentation to identify the offender's crime for which convicted or equivalent Wyoming offense, it shall register the offender as if he were convicted of an offense listed in subsection (j) of this section. If the division receives additional verifiable information or documentation that demonstrates that the offender was not convicted of an offense specified under subsection (j) of this section or an offense from any other jurisdiction containing the same or similar elements or arising out of the same or similar facts or circumstances, it shall modify the offender's status.
