

Wyoming Attorney General Peter Michael announced today that his office has promulgated emergency rules controlling four additional substances under Schedule I of the Wyoming Controlled Substances Act. All of those substances are synthetic compounds. They are:

1-pentyl-8-quinolinyl ester-1H-indole-3-carboxylic acid, **commonly known as PB-22;**

1-(5-fluoropentyl-8-quinolinyl ester-1H-indole-3-carboxylic acid, **commonly known as 5F- PB-22;**

1-pentyl-N-tricyclo[3.3.1.1^{3,7}]dec-1-yl-1H-indazole-3-carboxamide, **commonly known as AKB48;** and

N-((3s,5s,7s)-adamantan-1yl)-1-(5-flouropentyl)1H-indazole-3-carboxamide, **commonly known as 5F-AKB48**
