Re: Wyoming State Crime Laboratory Toxicology Drug Analysis

We are proud to announce that effective January 1, 2019, the Wyoming State Crime Lab (WSCL) will be accepting blood/urine collection kits for the presumptive analysis of drugs. The WSCL will also provide confirmatory drug analysis for THC, Methamphetamine, and related drugs.

A list of the specific drugs for which we can currently conduct confirmatory analysis are listed below:

**THC, Amphetamine, Diphenhydramine, Ketamine, LSD, MDA, MDMA, Mescaline, Methamphetamine, Phentermine, Psilocin, Ephedrine, and Pseudoephedrine.**

The WSCL Toxicology Unit will continue to expand its confirmatory analysis capabilities and will keep you advised as additional services become available. If the Toxicology Unit identifies a presumptive positive analysis for a drug that we are not currently capable of providing a confirmatory analysis, we will contact the submitting agency and provide a list of laboratories which offer confirmatory analysis. It will be up to the submitting agency to determine if a submission will be made to the private laboratory and all costs that are charged by the private laboratory will be the responsibility of the submitting agency.

Collection kits for Blood/Urine analysis for Alcohol and Drugs are available upon request at no cost to your departments. To order these collection kits, email your order request to include your point of contact, mailing address, and the number of requested collection kits (and types-blood/urine) to [dcj.tox@wyo.gov](mailto:dcj.tox@wyo.gov). When ordering, just remember that these collection kits have a shelf life of one year. If you previously purchased collection kits from the Chemical Testing Program, those kits will be accepted they the WSCL Toxicology Unit for alcohol and drug analysis.

All Toxicology submissions will follow the same procedure as all other analysis submissions that are sent to the WSCL. All submissions will be required to be entered into the WSCL Prelog system for proper tracking and reporting.

Coroners should already be listed in our system as submitters but may not have registered for Prelog. The Prelog Self-Registration Instructions are included at the bottom of this

letter. Please email [rodney.simmons@wyo.gov](mailto:rodney.simmons@wyo.gov) if you have any difficulties with registering.

- 1) The requester will need the Department Code. If you need to request this ID, email [rodney.simmons@wyo.gov](mailto:rodney.simmons@wyo.gov) for further assistance.
- 2) Go to the logon page and create a new USER ID - (do not enter a password, it will be created in the following steps.)
- 3) Press the Register Button to request an account.
- 4) Provide all the requested information.
- 5) You will receive an email when your new account has been activated. This account will be manually activated so allow for one week for the activation.
